CSX Index

On 5 May 2025, the CSX index saw an increase of 0.03%, closing at 410.73 points. Most stocks on the main board saw an increase; GTI increased by 0.85%, MJQE increased by 0.46%, PAS increased by 0.34%, PEPC increased by 9.02%, PPAP increased by 0.71%, and PWSA increased by 0.32%. Meanwhile, ABC decreased by 0.84%, and PPSP decreased by 0.47%. Only CGSM had no changes. Over on the growth board, both DBDE and JSL increased by 0.48% and 1.27%, respectively. The total trading volume for the day reached 131,547 shares, with a trading value of KHR 824 million.

Cambodia, US to begin trade talks in Washington on May 14-15

Cambodia and the United States will hold a new round of trade negotiations on May 14-15 in Washington, D.C., following virtual preparatory talks on May 2. Led by Deputy Prime Minister Sun Chanthol and US Trade Representative Sarah Ellerman, the talks aim to deepen economic ties and investment. Cambodia is pushing to expand market access and reduce tariffs on its exports, while the US appears to seek increased Cambodian imports of American goods. Business leader Lor Vichet proposed importing \$1 billion in US goods annually and suggested zero-percent tariffs on them to create a more favorable trade environment. *(Khmer Times)*

Techo International Airport construction reviewed ahead of operation on July 10

A joint working group meeting on Friday reviewed the near-complete construction of Cambodia's \$1.5 billion Techo International Airport (TIA), which is scheduled to begin operations on July 10, 2025. Chaired by Minister Mao Havannal and attended by Cambodia Airport Investment Co. Ltd. officials, the meeting focused on final construction stages, certification processes, and preparations for the airport's opening. Located about 20 km south of Phnom Penh, TIA is 96% complete and capable of handling large aircraft like the Airbus A380. The development comes as Cambodia's aviation sector saw record growth in 2024, with 6.2 million passengers served by 31 airlines. *(Khmer Times)*

Cambodia, Iran to firm up economic cooperation

Cambodia and Iran have agreed to strengthen long-term economic cooperation, focusing on sectors such as petrochemicals, nanotechnology, aerospace, construction, and infrastructure, including potential direct flights between Tehran and Phnom Penh. The agreement was discussed during a meeting in Phnom Penh between Cambodian Deputy Prime Minister Sun Chanthol and Iranian Ambassador Ali Akbar Nazari. Iran expressed interest in providing technical expertise and called for a bilateral investment protection treaty, while Cambodia welcomed Iranian investment and committed to fast-tracking the treaty review. *(Khmer Times)*
