CSX Index

On 4th December 2025, the CSX index rose by 0.22%, closing at 419.85 points. Most stocks on the Main Board showed mixed performance. ABC increased by 0.83% and PWSA by 0.64%, while GTI, PEPC, and PPAP declined by 0.57%, 1.44%, and 0.14%, respectively. CGSM, MJQE, PAS, and PPSP remained unchanged. On the Growth Board, DBDE showed no change, whereas JSL rose by 1.14%. The total trading volume for the day reached 53,679 shares, with a trading value of KHR 290 million.

Cambodia Trade Expo 2025 opens today, showcasing local strength and global opportunities

The 18th Cambodia Trade Expo (CTExpo) opened today at the PH Grand Hall in Borey Peng Huoth Boeung Snor, running from 4–7 December. The four-day event brings together Cambodian enterprises, local products, and regional exhibitors to showcase industrial capabilities, promote Cambodian-made goods, and attract international partners. Featuring sectors like manufacturing, agriculture, finance, and technology, CTExpo 2025 offers opportunities to expand markets, build partnerships, and exchange industry knowledge, while boosting economic growth and strengthening commercial links. US-ABC to set up permanent office in Cambodia

The US-ASEAN Business Council (US-ABC) will establish a permanent presence in Cambodia for the first time, reflecting growing US investor confidence in the Kingdom. Announced during meetings with Cambodian officials, the move highlights opportunities in industrial development, technology, digital finance, and tourism. Cambodian leaders welcomed the decision as a "great opportunity" to expand markets, strengthen private-sector collaboration, and support innovationdriven growth, while US representatives reaffirmed commitment to deepening trade and investment ties. Cambodia, China step up science and technology cooperation

Cambodia and China have launched the Cambodia-China Joint Research Program, marking a new chapter in bilateral scientific and technological collaboration. The program includes eight selected research projects focused on food security, public health, AI, and data science, supporting Cambodia's longterm development priorities. Announced during a ceremony in Phnom Penh with officials from both countries, the initiative builds on prior STI cooperation agreements and recent MoUs. China will provide substantial financial support for its research teams, while Cambodia offers institutional backing. Officials highlighted the program's role in promoting talent development, strengthening institutional linkages, and advancing a China-Cambodia community with a shared future, with a two-year execution cycle and continued collaboration through regional platforms.
